Davis Mac-Iyalla has been a leader in the struggle for Lesbian and Gay equality both within the Anglican Church and in his native Nigeria.

An activist against a threatened law that would ban gays from marrying, forming organizations, or gathering in any way, Mac-Iyalla has earned the virulent hostility of a leading proponent of the anti-gay law, Nigerian Anglican Archbishop Peter Akinola.

Repeated death threats have forced Mac-Iyalla to flee the country.
