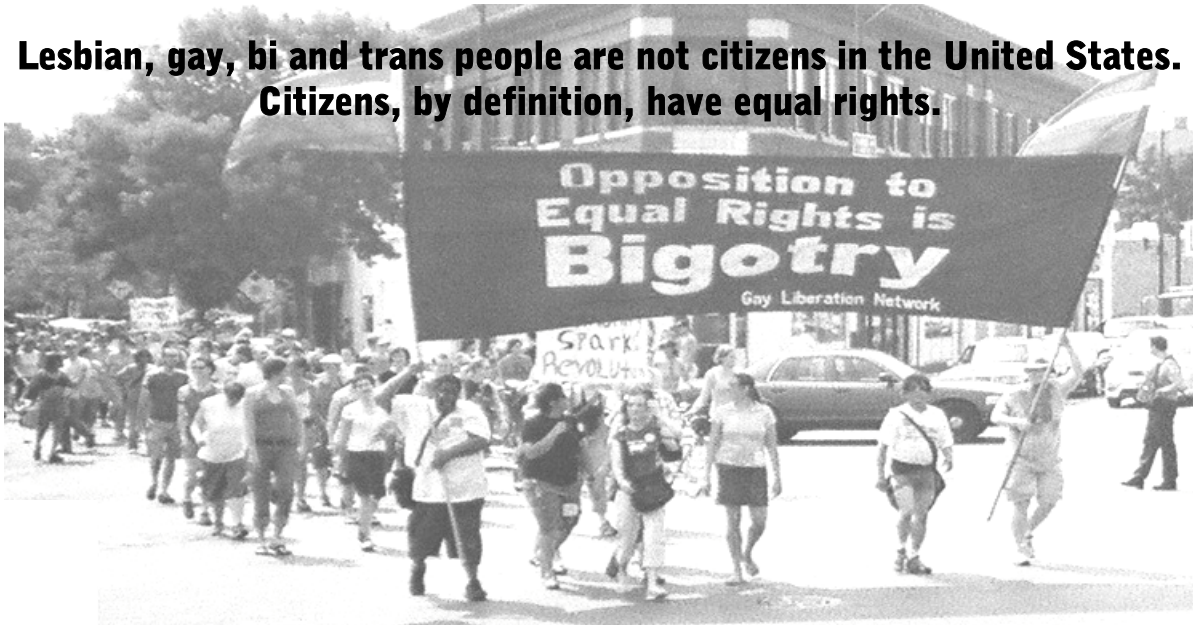


# Equality For ALL!

This vicious racism was partially dismantled only thanks to the massive outpouring of people into the streets of the nation through the great Civil Rights Movement of the 1950's and '60's.
