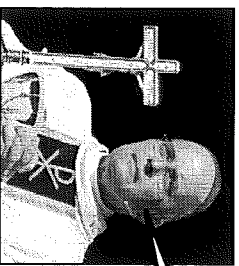


Freedom to Marry Day

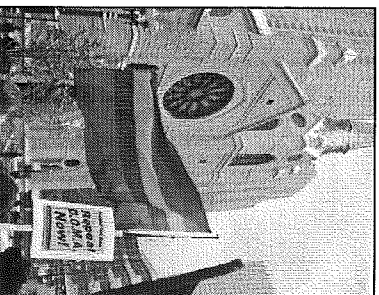

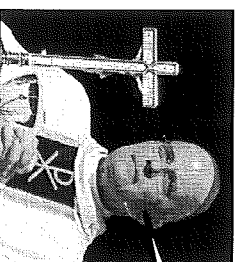

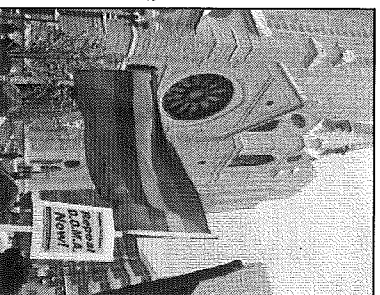
